Provided that nothing contained in this rule bar the appointment or employment of a subject of Nepal or Bhutan in the Force.

4. **PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES:-** The post will carry Pay Matrix Rs.21700-69100/- (Level-3) as per 7th CPC and other allowances as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. The selected candidates for the post of CT(GD) under Sports Quota will be governed under Contribution Pension Scheme (New Pension Scheme).

a) In case, a sportsperson produces a document regarding his/her achievement/ certificate after the submission of online application and upto the start of the documentation process, his/her achievement will be accepted and considered documentation process provided the qualifying documents are essentially required with the application form on or before the cut off date.

b) The closing date for receipt of applications will be 30 days from the date of publication of this advertisement in Employment News.

- c) The candidate must fulfill all eligibility criteria and must be in possession of all educational/professional/sports achievements and other certificates required for the post, issued by concerned authority as on last date of receipt of applications i.e. 30 days from the publication of this advertisement in Employment News.
- d) Date of Birth and Name as recorded in Matriculation certificate will be accepted for determining the age and name. No subsequent request for its change will be considered.

6. **AGE RELAXATION** :- Upper age limit shall be relaxable by five years for Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes and three years for other Backward classes. Also relaxable for Government servant and Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time.

*Children means (a) Son (including adopted son); or (b) Daughter (including adopted daughter) **Dependent family members mean:** (a) Spouse; or (b) Children; or Brother or Sister in the case of unmarried Govt. servant who were wholly dependent on the Govt. servant at the time of his killing in the riot. The candidate will have to produce a certificate to this effect, issued by the concerned District Collector to claim relaxation in age.

(ii) In case of candidates belonging to OBC category, the creamy layer status should have been obtained within preceding three years from the closing date of receipt of application as mentioned at para-5(b) above. The OBC certificate in prescribed format (Annexure-I) issued by a competent authority will only be accepted as proof of belonging to OBC category at the time of documentation.

(iii) Candidate who wishes to avail age relaxation must submit requisite certificate from the concerned Competent Authority, at the time of documentation.

(iv) The candidates seeking relaxation in age under SC/ST category will submit the SC/ST certificate as per Annexure-II issued by the District Authorities at the time of documentation. In the event of non-production of the certificate, their claim for SC/ST category will not be considered and the candidature of candidate will be cancelled straightway. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by SSB at later stage. Candidate is liable for cancellation of his/ her candidature due to non production of SC/ST certificate as per format at the time of documentation.

(v) The candidates seeking relaxation under OBC category should submit the certificate as per Annexure-I issued by District Authorities at the time of documentation. In the event of non-production of OBC certificate in the prescribed format, the candidate will be considered under unreserved category, if he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions prescribed for unreserved category candidate. Certificate on any other format will not be accepted and the candidature of candidate who wants to avail relaxation under OBC category will be cancelled straightaway. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained by SSB at later stage and candidate is liable for cancellation of his/her candidature due to non production of OBC certificate as per format at the time of documentation.

(vi) **DEFINITION/ SPECIAL INSTRUCTION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN :-**

(A) An 'ex-serviceman' means a person, who has served in any rank (whether as a combatant or non-combatant) in the Regular Army, Navy or Air Force of the Indian Union, and

(i) who either has been retired or relieved or discharged from such service whether at his own request or being relieved by the employer after earning his or her pension; or

(ii) who has been relieved from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service or circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension; or

(iii) who has been released from such service as a result of reduction in establishment

OR

(B) Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagement, otherwise than at his own request, or by way of dismissal, or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given a gratuity; and includes personnel of the Territorial Army, namely, pension holders for continuous embodied service or broken spells of qualifying service;

OR

(C) Personnel of the Army Postal Service who are part of Regular Army and retired from the Army Postal Service without reversion to their parent service with pension, or are released from the Army Postal service on medical grounds attributable to or aggravated by military service or circumstance beyond their control and awarded medical or other disability pension;

OR

(D) Personnel, who were on deputation in Army Postal Service for more than six months prior to the 14th April, 1987;

OR

(E) Gallantry award winners of the Armed forces including personnel of Territorial Army;

OR

(F) Ex-recruits boarded out or relieved on medical ground and granted medical disability pension.

- (G) The persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Union, who on retirement from service, would come under the category of ex-serviceman will be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified term of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to ex-servicemen but shall not be permitted to leave the uniform until they complete the specified term of engagement in the Armed Forces of the Union.
- (H) Ex-Servicemen (ESM) who have already secured employment in civil side under Government on regular basis after availing of the benefits of reservation given to ex-servicemen for their re-employment are not eligible for reservation in ESM category and fee concession. However, he can avail the benefit of reservation as ex-serviceman for subsequent employment if he immediately after joining civil employment, has given self-declaration/ undertaking to the concerned employer about the date-wise details of applications for various vacancies for which he had applied for before joining the initial civil employment as mentioned in the OM No. 36034/1/2014-Estt (Res) dated 14th August 2014 issued by DoP&T.
- (I) The period of "Call up Service" of an Ex-Serviceman in the Armed Forces shall also be treated as service rendered in the Armed Forces for the purpose of age relaxation.
- (J) For any serviceman of the three Armed Forces of the Union to be treated as Ex-Serviceman for the purpose of securing the benefits of reservation, he must have already acquired, at the relevant time of submitting his application for the Post/ Service, the status of ex-serviceman or is in a position to establish his acquired entitlement by documentary evidence from the competent authority that he would complete specified term of engagement with the Armed Forces within the stipulated period of one year from the closing date of receipt of applications. Such candidates must also acquire the status of an ex-serviceman within the stipulated period of one year from the closing date of receipt of applications. The decision on the issue of eligibility of ex-servicemen shall be governed by the decision taken by the DoP&T on the judgment of Hon'ble Delhi High Court in Writ Petition (C) No. 520/2020 dated 01.12.2020.

Note:- Age relaxation is not admissible to sons, daughters and dependents of ex-servicemen. Therefore, such candidates should not indicate their category as ex-servicemen.

7. Disqualification:-No person-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
- shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such a marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

8. **FEE PAYABLE AND MODE OF PAYMENT:** Unreserved, EWS and OBC category candidates are required to pay Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred) only being fees (non-refundable) through online mode. However, SC/ ST & Female candidates are exempted from payment of fees.

9. **SELECTION PROCESS:-**The selection process will be conducted following 02 (two) stages:-

- a) Stage-I for candidates with International participation/medal winners and National medal winner's upto 3rd place.

- b) Stage-II the second stage of recruitment will be conducted for other eligible candidates, if vacancies remained unfilled after selection of candidates having medals/participations in International and medals winners in national competitions upto 3rd place.

The bio-metric examination, photograph and signature of the candidates who report with Admit Card at the recruitment venue will be taken, which shall be followed by conduct of different stages of recruitment process as under:-

STAGE-I:- (For candidates with International participation/medal winners and National medal winner's upto 3rd place)

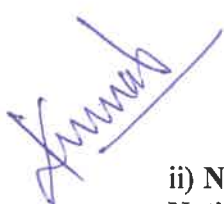
(a) **DOCUMENTATION:-** All candidates reporting for recruitment will have to go through documentation process, in which candidates will have to produce **all original** documents/certificates pertaining to age, education, caste, sports achievements, proof to avail age relaxation etc., failing which the candidature of candidate will be rejected. No appeal on rejection during documentation will be entertained by SSB at later stage.

(b) **CHECKING OF SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:-** i) Field trial/skill test will be exempted for those who have participated in any International Sports event as member of Indian Squad with clearance of the Department of Youth Affairs & Sports.

ii) Field trial/skill test will be exempted for those who have represented a State/UT in the Senior or Junior level National championship organized by the National Sports federations recognized by Department of Youth Affairs & Sports or National Games organized by Indian Olympic Association and have won medals or position upto 3rd place.

iii) Order of preference:- In this process all sports achievements of all candidates will be checked and according to their performance in games the marks will be awarded to them. The order of preference and Division of Marks is as under:-

(i) **First preference-** Candidates who have represented the country in an **International Competition** in any of games /sports mentioned at Para-3 with clearance of the Department of Youth Affairs and Sports. Candidates who have won Gold Medal will be given first preference followed by Silver (2nd preference) and then Bronze Medalist (3rd preference).

ii) **Next preference-** Candidates who have represented State/UT in **Senior or Junior level National Championship** organized by the National Sports Federation recognized by department of Youth Affairs and sports or National Games organized by Indian Olympic association and **have won medal or position up to third place**. Between the candidates participating or having participated & won medal in Senior/Junior National Championship/games, latter i.e participated and won medal(s) shall be given preference.

Note: -

- (i) In the event of a tie those who have secured a higher position or won more than one medal will be given the preference.
- (ii) Participation in individual and team event/item will be given the same preference.
- (iii) No marks will be given for winning more than one medal/position.
- (iv) In case of any doubt about the status of a tournament, the matter will be referred to the DoP&T in consultation with Department of Sports & Youth Affairs and decision will be final and binding.
